



Daaga' Awards

BACKGROUND

Daaga' represents the unified efforts of Native leaders to promote drug- and alcohol-free communities. The awards were started in February 1990. Since then, Doyon, Limited has awarded over \$160,000 to individuals and organizations whose focus is on the prevention of alcohol and drug abuse.

Daaga' encompasses the following beliefs:

The source of healing lies in the ability of local people to help themselves

We should utilize the strength of our traditional values to focus on a healthy vision of the future

We should work together to promote programs that integrate the spiritual, social and economic needs of our people.

Daaga' proposals should address the following:

Events/programs should look into other sources of financial support as Daaga' awards are limited and new applicants will be given preference

Events/programs should promote traditional values (e.g. traditional artwork instruction, learning beadwork, hunting, trapping, as well as promoting drug and alcohol free lifestyles)

Event/program should be well advertised to surrounding areas to include the greatest number of shareholders.

Awards are granted up to **\$3,000** per funding period. Depending on the number of proposals received and the need, the selected proposals may not always be funded for the full amount requested. For this reason, Daaga' was created to be a start up resource; therefore priority may be given to new proposals.



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Following are the guidelines for project Daaga' applications:

1. The proposal must include the purpose and goal of the project in a 1 to 2 page format to include:
 - a. A description of the individual or organization requesting the funding
 - i. Address
 - ii. Contact person name, phone and email address
 - b. A statement of need (a budget or a list of other funding sources)
 - c. A project description and a timeline
 - d. And the name, mailing address, email address (if applicable), and telephone number of a contact person
 - e. A letter of support from your village council and/or village corporation
2. **Daaga' should be considered a supplement to the funding for a project.**
3. Applicants who are awarded the Daaga' grant, **must submit a report to include: pictures and/or video to the Shareholder Relations department immediately after their program is complete.** This information will be compiled into a presentation to be displayed at the following year annual meeting.

Applications will be mailed to all village council offices, and are also available on the Doyon, Limited website.
